Recent roles include *Siegfried* in excerpts from *Siegfried* with Boulder Opera; Froh in *Das Rheingold* with Arizona Opera; Števa in Janáček’s *Jenůfa* with Pacific Opera Victoria; Jonathan Dale in *Silent Night* with Michigan Opera Theatre, Austin Opera, and Minnesota Opera; The Prince in *Rusalka* with Madison Opera; and Ben Marco in *The Manchurian Candidate* with Austin Opera. On the concert stage, he has been heard in Verdi’s *Requiem*, Beethoven’s *Symphony No. 9*, and Aldridge’s *Parables*. He currently serves as an Assistant Professor of Voice at Colorado State University in Fort Collins, Colorado.
