

VACCINATION & MASK POLICY

Voices West is looking forward to welcoming audiences while keeping the health and safety of guests, staff, volunteers and our performers a top priority. We want you to feel safe and secure so that you can fully enjoy our concerts. To that end, we have developed the following policies and protocols that are in place as of October 14, 2021.

Please note, the below protocols will continue to be regularly evaluated and updated based on community health data and public health and government guidance. Please check back here for updates in advance of scheduled performances.

VACCINES

- **Voices West requires that all patrons are fully vaccinated against COVID-19** before attending indoor seated performances. To qualify as “fully vaccinated,” an individual must have completed their full course of COVID-19 shot(s) 14 days prior to an event and show proof of vaccine at entrance.
- At the current time, we are unable to accommodate children under 12 who are not fully vaccinated, or any other unvaccinated guests, singers, staff, or volunteers for public performances.

MASKS

- **Masks are required for all audience members.** Audience members must wear masks at all times.
- **I am unable to wear a mask, what are my options?**
 - We encourage you to attend a performance in the future when these requirements are lifted. All audience must wear a mask.

Voices West’s singers, instrumentalists, and conductors are all fully vaccinated. We will perform masked.

ASSISTANCE

Front Line Staff including Security personnel, ushers, instructors and event managers are

trained to assist guests and ensure that safety measures are followed. If you feel uncomfortable at any time, please speak with one of these team members.

PRIOR TO YOUR VISIT

SICK POLICY

If you are unwell, please stay home. If you or a member of your party is experiencing symptoms similar to those of COVID-19 or have had known exposure to someone with COVID-19, please stay home.

COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR GUESTS

If you are the ticket purchaser, it is your responsibility to communicate the Voices West vaccination and mask policy to others in your party.

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU ARRIVE

All staff, volunteers and contractors are required to be vaccinated.

Arrive early to allow extra time to provide proof of vaccination prior to entering into the event.

Hand sanitizer will be available.

Doors will open 30 minutes before the performance. Please move swiftly to your seat and don't linger unnecessarily in the lobby. If waiting for performers after the concert, please move outdoors to greet them.

Stay in your seat unless using the restroom.

FAQ

How do I show proof of vaccination when I arrive?

- Acceptable proof of vaccination may include one of the following that matches a government issued photo I.D. or school I.D. for youth:
 1. A physical copy of a WHO (World Health Organization) or FDA-approved COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card

2. A high-resolution photograph of the front and back of your WHO/FDA issued COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card on smart phone

3. Proof of your vaccination card on the accepted mobile device app MyColorado.

3. No facial covering, no entry applies to all

What if I forget my proof of vaccination?

- If you forget any documentation required (acceptable forms of proof of vaccination are listed above), you will not be permitted to enter the performance.

I have no intention of getting vaccinated, what are my options?

- We encourage you to attend a performance in the future when these requirements are lifted.

Covid Warning:
